

# GAPS IN SUPPORT

Homelessness has been on the rise in central Iowa. Senior citizens make up the fastest growing segment, and more than one-third of Iowa's homeless population are families with children. In 2024, Joppa served more than 2,224 homeless people, a 256% increase from 2021. Many of our neighbors have no options, home or hope.

On any given night, more than 1,200 central Iowans have no place to call home. Many of our neighbors sleep in cars, under bridges and in the woods trying to survive until morning.
